ENTRY FEES: \$5 first entry & \$3 same dog second entry

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES: All entrants will be sent a judging program with directions to the grounds and a running order. These will be mailed after the closing date of November 8, 2002. *Telephone messages concerning the match will be returned on a collect basis.* If you wish confirmation of RECEIPT of entries, enclose a pre-addressed, post paid post card. It will be returned. Entries including an e-mail address will be acknowledged by e-mail.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons.

CLASS INFORMATION

Dogs shall not be eligible to participate in more than one Regular Standard Class & one Regular Jumpers with Weaves (JWW) class OR one Preferred Standard Class and one Preferred JWW Class in a sanctioned agility match.

Novice Agility Class

The Novice Agility class is divided into Division A for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title from any organization, and Division B for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility Judges.

Open Agility Class

Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility titles, but that have not acquired the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Excellent Class

Division A is for dogs that have acquired the Open Agility Title but that have not acquired a qualifying score in the Excellent B Class. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the AX title and for dogs that have acquired the MX title.

Preferred Class Information

The owner/handler may choose to enter the Preferred Standard Class and Preferred JWW Class in lieu of entering the Regular Standard Class and the Regular JWW Class. The dog must be entered only in Preferred Classes or in Regular Classes, with no crossover between them being allowed.

All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time MUST enter the Novice level in both the Preferred Standard Agility Class and/or the Preferred JWW class regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes.

(There is no grandfathering of titles for the Regular Classes to the Preferred Classes or from the Preferred Classes to the Regular Classes. These Classes are separate titling programs and in both cases the dogs must start at the Novice level.)

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.

All dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary Jump Height Card shall be measured by a judge of record prior to competing (except those in the 24" height division).

Height at Withers	Regular Classes Jump Heights	Preferred Classes Jump Heights
10 inches or less	8 Inches	4 inches
14 inches or less	12 Inches	8 inches
18 inches or less	16 inches	12 inches
22 inches or less	20 inches	16 inches
Greater than 22 inches	24 inches	20 inches

If a dog's height at the withers exceeds the maximum allowed for the jump height in which the dog is entered, the dog shall be moved up into the proper jump height if the dog is measured prior to its run. In no case may a dog be moved down in height based on a judge's measurement at a match.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This match is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registrable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breeds and breeds not registrable with the AKC are not eligible to enter. Refer to Chapter 2 of the AKC Registration and Discipline Rules for a list of registrable breeds that may participate.

WALK-THROUGHS: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, before or following the judge's briefing.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS: Novice A & B dogs and handlers **only** will be given a familiarization period prior to the start of judging during which they may perform each of the contact obstacles. Dogs may work on or off lead and will perform contact obstacles one at a time. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat buckle collars, but there shall be no tags or attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Class Order

This is a one-ring match. Standard and JWW classes will be judged in the following order within each jump height:

Excellent B, A, Preferred
Open, Preferred
Novice B, A, Preferred

Standard classes will be judged first. JWW classes will be judged following the completion of Standard classes.

Running Order will be determined at the time of closing of entries and will be included in the Judging Schedule, which will be sent to all exhibitors.

Move-Ups must be received in writing (e-mail is acceptable) by the Match Secretary no later than noon on Monday, November 18th.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this match, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

Puppies under 6 months of age are strictly prohibited from the grounds.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring, when in the designated agility warm-up area, when crated, or when in a secure ex-pen.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS (Cont'd)

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Obstacles will include a 9ft A-Frame and 12ft Dog Walk. All equipment used will meet current AKC specifications.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Match Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the match cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Catalogs are available on a prepaid basis only for \$4.00. There will be no catalogs available for sale on the day of the Match.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Match Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund will be made of any entry fees paid.

As **bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Sanctioned Matches, the Club will refund all but two dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Match Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund at the match or by letter postmarked by November 18, 2002, or earlier.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Match Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Please clean up after your dog - there will be pooper scoopers available for your use.

There will be FOOD AND DRINKS available on site for volunteers. No food or drinks will be available for sale. There is limited shade available. The match will be held outdoors on grass, rain or shine. Ring size is 140' x 140'.
